

## **Operation and Safety Rules**

Only adult Renters who have signed the Rental Agreement and Waiver of Liability (“Agreement”) shall operate any UTV.

Children of any age are welcome to ride at Renter’s risk. BRR is not responsible for any injury or death of a child.

Eye protection is strongly recommended while operating or riding in a UTV. Helmets and goggles are available upon request.

Do not carry more people than the UTV is designed for. Riding on laps or in the bed of the UTV is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

Please proceed with caution if a pet is on board. BRR is not responsible for any injury or death of a pet.

Do not operate any UTV or other vehicle in a reckless or dangerous manner.

Do not break any laws regarding speed or location while operating any UTV. Obey all signs and posted speed limits.

You must be seated with your safety belt fastened at all times. Headlights must always be on.

Be aware that passengers affect how the UTV handles.

The UTVs handle differently while in 4-wheel drive. Do NOT use 4-wheel drive on pavement.

Operate the UTV at safe speeds within the limits of the machine and the operator’s skill level.

Assess the terrain before crossing. Do not drive into deep water or deep mud holes. Watch for cliffs and drop-offs.

Avoid contact with wildlife and keep a safe viewing distance.

Be aware of other riders and vehicles. Slow down when approaching a blind corner.

DO NOT enter posted Private Property. DO NOT drive or park on any beaches or sand dunes at any time.

Do not participate in any race or other contest involving UTVs or other vehicles.

Do not tow other UTVs, trailers or other vehicles and do not have them tow you and your rental UTV or other rental vehicles. If you need assistance, please call Big Rock Rental.

If you are issued a citation or fine for any reason, you are responsible for payment of such fines.

No alcohol consumption before or during use and possession of rented UTV.

Do not leave UTV unattended with key in the ignition.

In case of a breakdown, call Big Rock Rental at 231-622-9543. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REPAIR A DAMAGED UTV. Do not leave a disabled UTV alone at any time.

UTVs are to be returned on time.

There are no refunds for early returns or inclement weather.
